Through our unique location on the campus of Saint John's University and partnership with College of Saint Benedict, our students have access to facilities on both campuses.

RESIDENCE HALLS

As the place where we begin to build community, Saint Michael Hall (boys' residence) and Emmaus Hall (girls' residence) are home to our boarding and international students in grades 9-12. These residence halls host social events and include both single and double rooms, study areas, free laundry, kitchens and plenty of storage space for bikes, skis, and other recreational equipment.







ACADEMIC LIBRARIES

Both the Saint John's Prep and Saint John's University libraries support the development of critical thinking, personal inquiry, creative expression, and lifelong learning.

Students have access to rich collections, expert assistance, and effective learning spaces right here on campus.

STUDENT DINING

With four unique on-campus dining facilities to choose from, our students enjoy a variety of cafeteria and a-la-carte dining options. Students are also allowed to order in their local favorites.

ACTIVITIES

All students are required to participate in extracurricular activities for their physical and social development.

Saint John's Prep has over 40 clubs and activities to choose from, including music, theater, visual arts, and 19 competitive Minnesota State High School League athletic programs.

ATHLETICS & RECREATION


Resident students stay busy with supervised use of the fitness center, swimming pool, basketball/volleyball courts, racquetball courts, indoor climbing wall, indoor/outdoor track and tennis courts.

In the warmer months, students can spend time on Lake Sagatagan swimming at the beach, canoeing, kayaking, paddle boarding, or cycling around the lake. The winter months are a great time to take advantage of the sledding hill, ice fishing, or snowshoeing through the woods surrounding our campus.











STUDENT SERVICES

COLLEGE COUNSELING AND PREPARATION

Students meet with a college counselor to guide them in the college admission process, assisting with college search, application preparation, and institution selection. There are opportunities for ACT, SAT, and TOEFL test preparation throughout the school year, and transportation is provided to local testing sites.

IMMIGRATION SERVICES

Students receive immigration guidance and support prior to arriving at Saint John's Prep until they graduate and move on to the college of their choice. Immigration forms are monitored and updated for SEVIS each semester for enrollment verification, travel, change of status, and final transfer for all students on an F1 Student Visa.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT **COUNSELING SERVICES**

International students have a dedicated counselor who works with them and their parents as they navigate the college search and application process.

Additionally, the international counselor works to ensure that a student's personal and academic needs are met and their transition to the U.S. goes smoothly.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE SERVICES (ESOL)

Both intermediate and advanced ESOL classes are offered for international students. The courses use motivating and relevant multimedia content aimed specifically at teenage learners to advance the listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills necessary for intercultural communication and cross-curricular academic success. In addition to our regular ESOL classes, we also offer tailored individual and small-group tutoring to help ESOL students meet the demands of studying in mainstream classes by focusing on the subjects and language skills they find most challenging.

SAFETY AND SECURITY

In partnership with Saint John's University, our students have access to security and medical services 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from Life Safety Services. Campus patrol, emergency medical response, and a 24-hour escort service are just some of the services provided.

TRANSPORTATION

Our full-time, dedicated residence hall staff, are available to transport students as needed. Transportation to medical appointments, standardized testing sites, and local food establishments is available. A shuttle service makes regular stops to campus, an added convenience for transportation to the airport. Busing is also available to a variety of locations.

When our students are not busy studying, they have opportunities to enjoy a variety of on and off campus activities. We are just minutes away from shopping, restaurants, entertainment, and more.

DIVERSITY

Our vibrant student body is made up of day, domestic boarding, and international students from around the United States and the world. Approximately 25% of our student body consists of international students, representing between 10-15 different countries.

EXTENDED BREAKS

Traditionally, our students return home or travel with their families during the winter and summer breaks. There are other times throughout the year that the residence halls are closed, and other activities are organized for students unable to return home. Based on student interest, past trips have included Chicago, San Diego, New York, Boston, and Orlando. Students are also encouraged to stay with a local family to experience more culture during these breaks.














PEER MENTORS






SCHEDULE


BEYOND ORDINARY

Saint John's Prep is an independent college preparatory school guided by Benedictine values. Students in grades six through twelve from diverse backgrounds immerse themselves in a learning environment surrounded by the natural beauty of our pristine woods and lakes shared with Saint John's University.

Students will be challenged to engage deeply in learning; foster and participate in an inclusive community; and grow into adults who are intellectually adventurous, ethically sure-footed, and generous of heart and spirit. Students will believe in themselves, aspire to greatness, and view the world with a global perspective.

Saint John's Prep is a recognized International Baccalaureate (IB) World School through the IB Diploma Programme – an optional two-year program of rigorous study during a student's junior and senior years. Students study in six academic areas: language; second language; mathematics; science; individuals and society; and the arts.
