- Unique electives are offered every semester that allow students to customize their schedule with a variety of engaging, handson courses



A DAY IN THE LIFE

Middle school classrooms are located in our 22,000 square-foot addition, adjacent to our main building overlooking the athletic fields and the beautiful nature surrounding our campus. Middle school students have their own exclusive commons area and kitchen to enjoy free time and collaborative study with their fellow middle school students.

Our students attend core academic subjects each day – Science, English, Social Studies, Math, and World Language. Every other day, they have flexibility built into their schedule. Theology, Music (band, choir, orchestra), Visual Arts, and Physical Education are offered and all students participate.

Students also choose from a variety of electives including Outdoor Skills, Game Strategies, Woodcraft 101, Nutrition and Healthy Living, Ancient and Modern Technology, and Computer Programming.

There is never a shortage of fresh air for our students as they enjoy time outside throughout the day as part of their classes and break times.

PREMIER OUTDOOR LEARNING

The Saint John's Prep experience provides the opportunity for students to connect with nature, experience "hands on" learning, and develop an appreciation for the natural world around them. Our elective classes also provide students the opportunity to learn outdoor skills such as canoe paddling, orienteering, and snow shelter construction.







Music








BEYOND ORDINARY
